

# COVID-19 Vaccines Pre-registration

## **Sunnybrook Hospital:**

### Vaccine pre-registration for eligible North Toronto residents

Sunnybrook is accepting pre-registration for the COVID-19 vaccine from North Toronto residents who meet the Government of Ontario's eligibility criteria during the current phase of Ontario's vaccine rollout.

Eligible North Toronto residents who may pre-register for a COVID-19 vaccine during this phase of the Government of Ontario's vaccine rollout include:

- **Any North Toronto resident who is 80 years of age or older (those born in 1941 or earlier)**
- Indigenous adults
- Adults who receive home care
- Health-care workers (a person who works in a health-care setting in any capacity)

### **What it means to pre-register?**

Pre-registration means that Sunnybrook is allowing eligible groups (as defined by the Ontario Ministry of Health) to indicate that they wish to be vaccinated once it is their turn. After you pre-register, your information is sent to Sunnybrook's vaccine clinic.

If you have pre-registered with Sunnybrook and meet the pre-registration criteria, the vaccine clinic will send you an invitation to book an appointment at a vaccine clinic once you are eligible to receive the vaccine.

**Please note: Pre-registering does not guarantee a vaccine appointment at Sunnybrook's COVID-19 vaccine clinic.**

# **North York General and North York Toronto**

### Vaccine pre-registration for eligible North York area residents

North York General Hospital and North York Toronto Health Partners are now pre-registering eligible priority groups in the North York area following Phase 1 of the provincial [vaccination plan](#)

Eligible residents who may pre-register for a COVID-19 vaccine during this phase of the Government of Ontario's vaccine rollout include:

- **People who are 80 years of age and older (born in 1941 or before)**
- Health care workers in High Priority

**Pre-registration is ONLY available to eligible PRIORITY GROUPS, including people who are aged 80 years of age and older who have not been vaccinated**

- People 80 years of age and older (born in 1941 or before)

NOTE: A special phone line will be made available later the week of March 1 to allow people to register for their vaccination booking by phone and to answer questions about vaccination.

Eligibility will be confirmed before any appointment is booked. Due to limited supply, COVID-19 vaccination appointments are not available for the general public. No walk-ins will be accepted at clinic locations.

### **What you will need to complete the pre-registration form:**

- Contact information including postal code
- Cell/mobile phone number (preferred) or home phone number
- Email address
- Priority group
